1. CALL TO ORDER AND INTRODUCTIONS

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 AM, on July 10, 2025 by Chair Griffith. A quorum was present.

2. Approve the 568th TTC Meeting Agenda

Chair Griffith asked if there were any questions or changes to the July 10, 2025 TTC Meeting Agenda.

Motion: Approve the May 08, 2025 TTC Meeting Agenda Mr. McCamy moved, seconded by Mr. Grittner MOTION, PASSED.

Motion carried unanimously.

3. Approve May 8, 2025 TTC MEETING MINUTES

Chair Griffith asked if there were any questions or changes to the May 8, 2025 TTC Meeting Minutes (the June 12th meeting was canceled due to lack of agenda items)

Motion: Approve the May 8, 2025 TTC Minutes.

Mr. Trowbridge moved, seconded by Mr. Hutchings

4. Public Comment Opportunity

No public comments were made or received.

5. Federal Functional Classification Update for 2025 (Minnesota)

Ms. Beierle Pavek presented information for Minnesota functional classification. The last update for Minnesota Federal Functional class was done 2015. Staff worked with the affected jurisdictions to review and discuss the changes which include roadways, urbanized area boundaries, closures, and Federal guidance.

There is an increase of approximately 43 miles of roadway and a decrease of approximately 2 miles of major collectors. Federal guidelines include speed, traffic, shoulder width, access spacing, and existing land use.

Some state aid roads will be changing which could change functional classification. After further discussion, the MN jurisdictions involved with MN Federal classification asked if they could take a final look at the map before recommending approval at the Policy Board.

Motion: Table Federal Functional Classification until the next meeting to give time for follow-up with jurisdictions/state agencies. Mr. Trowbridge moved, seconded by Mr. Sorum MOTION, PASSED Motion carried unanimously.

6. Review Draft 2026-2027 UPWP and Budget

Mr. Griffith presented the draft UPWP and Budget for 2026-2027. The 2027 numbers are based off a 2% increase from the 2026 estimates. The potential projects are not in any specific order and will have to be prioritized.

A summary of costs by program areas including staff hours, jurisdiction dues, and project budgets were included for further discussion. This was just the preliminary with more finalized information in the final UPWP and Budget.

Mr. Trowbridge asked what the odds are some of the current studies will be completed this year. Mr. Griffith stated that it was looking like all but one project currently underway would be completed this year, most within the next few months. He noted that the 2026 UPWP Budget included approximately \$170,000 in unused 2024 CPG funds, and had no idea what it would be in the future.

Motion: Recommend approval of draft 2026-2027 UPWP and Budget to Policy Board.

7. 2025-2028 TIP Amendment 7

Mr. Bervik presented Amendment 7 regarding the 2025-2028
Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). A public notice was published on Wednesday, June 25, 2025, and comments would be accepted until 12:00 noon on Thursday, July 10, 2025. At the time of the meeting, no comments had been received.

The proposed amendment to the 2025-2028 TIP is as follows:

- 1. **Modification of Project 9256057:** NDDOT hazard elimination improvements at railroad crossing (2025). Updating project location, project description, and the cost breakdown.
- 2. **Removal of Project 4250020:** City of Fargo adaptive traffic signal corridor along 45th Street (2026). Removal of Federal Funding.
- 3. **Modification of Project 3250022:** City of West Fargo construction of a shared use path and pedestrian bridge crossing the Sheyenne River in the River's Bend Area (2026). Moving the project from 2027 and updating the cost breakdown for the available 2026 CRP funding.
- 4. **Modification of Project 7250021:** City of Horace construction of a shared use path along 76th Avenue South (2027). Updating cost breakdown.
- 5. **Modification of Project 4230003:** City of Fargo construction of a pedestrian bridge in the vicinity of Bluestem Amphitheater in conjunction with the City of Moorhead. (2027). Updating total project cost, cost breakdown, and project description.
- 6. **Modification of Project 5250005**: City of Moorhead replacement of HPS lighting heads with LED lighting heads at various locations. (2026). Updating total project cost and cost breakdown.
- 7. **Removal of Project 5250001:** City of Moorhead mill and overlay of 40th Avenue South from 8th Street to 40th Street (2026). Removal of Federal Funding.
- 8. **Removal of Project 8257061:** City of Dilworth pedestrian drain crossing and path on 40th Street North from 4th Avenue NW to 3rd Avenue NW (2026). Removal of Federal Funding.
- 9. **New Project 5257059:** City of Moorhead construction of a pedestrian bridge in the vicinity of Bluestem Amphitheater in conjunction with the City of Fargo. (2026) Minnesota STBG funding
- 10. **New Project 5257060:** City of Moorhead construction of a pedestrian bridge in the vicinity of Bluestem Amphitheater in conjunction with the City of Fargo. (2026) Minnesota CRP Funding.

Motion: Recommend approval of Amendment 7 of the Metro COG 2025-2028 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to the Policy Board.

Mr. Mastera moved, seconded by Mr. Trowbridge MOTION, PASSED Motion carried unanimously.
