**Re:** *Amendment #1 to the 2018-2021 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the Fargo-Moorhead Metropolitan Area*

The Fargo-Moorhead Metropolitan Council of Governments (Metro COG) held public meetings at the Case Plaza Conference Room at One 2nd Street North, Suite 232, in Fargo, North Dakota on Thursday, November 9, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. and on Thursday, November 16, 2017 at 4:00 p.m. to consider public comments regarding the proposed Amendment #1 to the 2018-2021 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the FM Metropolitan Area. The proposed amendment to the 2018-2021 TIP is as follows:

1. Modification of Project 518011: project received additional Federal funding bringing the total project cost to \$2,580,000 of which \$1,626,233 is being funded by ATIP managed STBGP funds, \$383,700 from Advanced Construction funds (STBGP payback in 2019), and \$570,067 from matching local funds.
2. Modification of Project 218011: Parke Ave rehabilitation with construction of a multi-use trail. Project total increased to \$5,208,895 of which \$375,000 is being funded by TA funds (for the construction of the trail), and the remainder funded through local means.
3. Addition of Project 5180021: Purchase of one (1) Class 700 fixed-route transit bus. The total project cost is \$495,000 of which \$396,000 is being funded through FTA 5339 funds and \$99,000 through local matching funds.
4. Addition of Project 5180022: ROW Acquisition for the 11<sup>th</sup> Street Railroad Grade Separation. The total project cost is \$531,993 of which \$425,594 is being funded by Federal STBGP funds, and \$106,399 through local matching funds.

The public was notified of the proposed 2018-2021 TIP amendment as per the adopted Metro COG Public Participation Plan (PPP). Public comments were accepted by Metro COG until 12:00 noon November 16, 2017. No public comments were received by Metro COG either verbally during the public hearing nor by written statement.

The Policy Board at their November 16, 2017 meeting considered and approved the attached amendments. The updated TIP project sheet reflecting the amendment is attached.



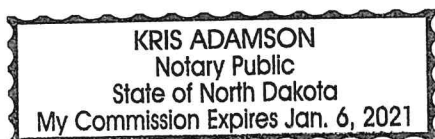

## Public Meeting Notice: Amendment to the Metro COG 2018-2021 Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program

Notice is hereby given that the Fargo-Moorhead Metropolitan Council of Governments (Metro COG) will hold a public meeting at the Case Plaza Conference Room at One 2nd Street North, Suite 232, in Fargo, North Dakota on Thursday, November 16, 2017 at 4:00 p.m. to consider public comments regarding proposed amendments to the 2018-2021 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the FM Metropolitan Area. The Metro COG TIP is the listing of significant surface transportation improvements scheduled for implementation. Metro COG develops and maintains the TIP in cooperation with the North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT), the Minnesota Department of Transportation (Mn/DOT), county and municipal jurisdictions and Metro Area Transit (MATBUS) of Fargo-Moorhead.

All comments received will be deliberated by the Metro COG Policy Board prior to consideration of the proposed TIP amendment. Metro COG Policy Board action regarding the proposed TIP amendments will occur on Nov 16, 2017. The proposed amendments to the 2018-2021 TIP are as follows:

1. Modification of Project 518011: project received additional Federal funding bringing the total project cost to \$2,625,000 of which \$1,626,233 is being funded by ATIP managed STBGP funds, \$383,700 from Advanced Construction funds (STBGP payback in 2019), and \$615,067 from matching local funds.
2. Modification of Project 218011: Parke Ave rehabilitation with construction of a multi-use trail. Project total increased to \$5,208,895 of which \$375,000 is being funded by TA funds (for the construction of the trail), and the remainder funded through local means.
3. Addition of Project 5170021: Purchase of one (1) Class 700 fixed-route transit bus. The total project cost is \$495,000 of which \$396,000 is being funded through FTA 5339 funds and \$99,000 through local matching funds.
