#### 1. CALL TO ORDER AND INTRODUCTIONS

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 am, on May 13, 2021 by Chair Gray. A quorum was present.

# 2. Approve the 518th TTC Meeting Agenda

Chair Gray asked if there were any questions or changes to the 518th TTC Meeting Agenda.

Motion: Approve the 518th TTC Meeting Agenda. Mr. Sahr moved, seconded by Ms. Huston MOTION, PASSED. Motion carried unanimously.

# 3. APPROVE April 8, 2021 TTC MEETING MINUTES

Chair Gray asked if there were any questions or changes to the April 8, 2021 TTC Meeting Minutes.

Motion: Approve the April 8, 2021 TTC Minutes. Mr. Smith moved, seconded by Ms. Bommelman MOTION, PASSED Motion carried unanimously.

#### 4. Public Comment Opportunity

No public comments were made or received.

#### 5. FM Metro Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan Update Consultant Selection

Mr. Farnsworth presented Alta Planning + Design as the highest ranked consultant for the FM Metro Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan Update. Metro COG received three proposals from Alta, Ulteig Engineering, and Toole Design.

Alta's cost proposal came in at \$169,951, which is within the project's budgeted amount of \$170,000.

Motion: Recommend Policy Board approval of Metro COG entering into a contract with Alta Planning + Design for the Fargo-Moorhead Metropolitan Bicycle & Pedestrian Plan Update.

Mr. Mastera moved, seconded by Ms. Bommelman MOTION, PASSED Motion carried unanimously.

#### 6. 17th Street N Corridor Study Final Report

Mr. Farnsworth introduced Mr. Champa as the project lead, and Mr. Champa introduced Mr. Mertz and Mr. Christianson as the Consultant project managers from Bolton and Menk. Mr. Mertz and Mr. Christianson presented the final report for the Moorhead 17<sup>th</sup> Street North Corridor Study.

The recommended alternatives include on-street bike lanes, 10' shared-use paths, and marked crosswalks.

The project had a 100% virtual Public Input, as the project spanned most of the COVID-19 pandemic and nationwide shut down. Despite the virtual approach, there was a high turnout for returned surveys and public comment.

Motion: Recommend Approval of the 17th Street N Corridor Study to the Metro COG Policy Board.

Ms. Huston moved, seconded by Mr. Smith

MOTION, PASSED

Motion carried unanimously.

# 7. Employment & Household Data – Vendor Selection

Mr. Maddox presented Data-Axel (formerly Infogroup USA) as the preferred vendor for the Employment and Household Data purchase. NDSU/ATAC's Diomo Motuba contributed greatly to the specifications provided to vendors and also in the selection of vendors.

Out of four vendors solicited, Data-Axel (formerly Infogroup USA), Cochava, and Replica submitted proposals. \$5,534 was the final amount for the purchase of one month's worth of data. As this amount is less than \$10,000, this purchase falls under the Level 1 Micro Purchase, which does not require a full RFP process.

Motion: Recommend selection of Data-Axel to the Policy Board as the preferred vendor to supply employment and household data to Metro COG.

Mr. Benson moved, seconded by Mr. Sahr

MOTION, PASSED

Motion carried unanimously.

## 8. Draft 2022 Budget

Ms. Gray presented the draft 2022 budget, including local share amounts for member jurisdictions.

Mr. Solberg stated that West Fargo would not have an issue with the increase in the dues formula for their jurisdiction. Mr. Solberg said that the agency should trust its own population estimates and forecasting, and feels comfortable moving forward with the revised formula. He did also state that he will make the motion, but will default to the Policy Board to make the final decision at their meeting.

Motion: Recommend approval of the draft 2022 budget to the Policy Board using a revised dues formula based on the 2019 population estimates.

Mr. Solberg moved, seconded by Mr. Raso

MOTION, PASSED

Motion carried unanimously.

## 9. COVID-19 Analysis and Monitoring Report

Mr. Champa presented a COVID-19 Analysis and Monitoring Report. Mr. Champa and Mr. Del Rosario used StreetLight Data and Strava to compile the data for this report. Mr. Raso expressed interest in collaborating with Metro COG and other jurisdictions to share this type of data.

Mr. Farnsworth presented an update on the Fargo-Moorhead Metro Area-Wide Traffic Count project. The consultant has completed almost 60% of the counts, with 50% of those counts having been reviewed and completed. The counts will be completed by this fall, as they plan to finish the counts when the area colleges/universities are back in regular session.
