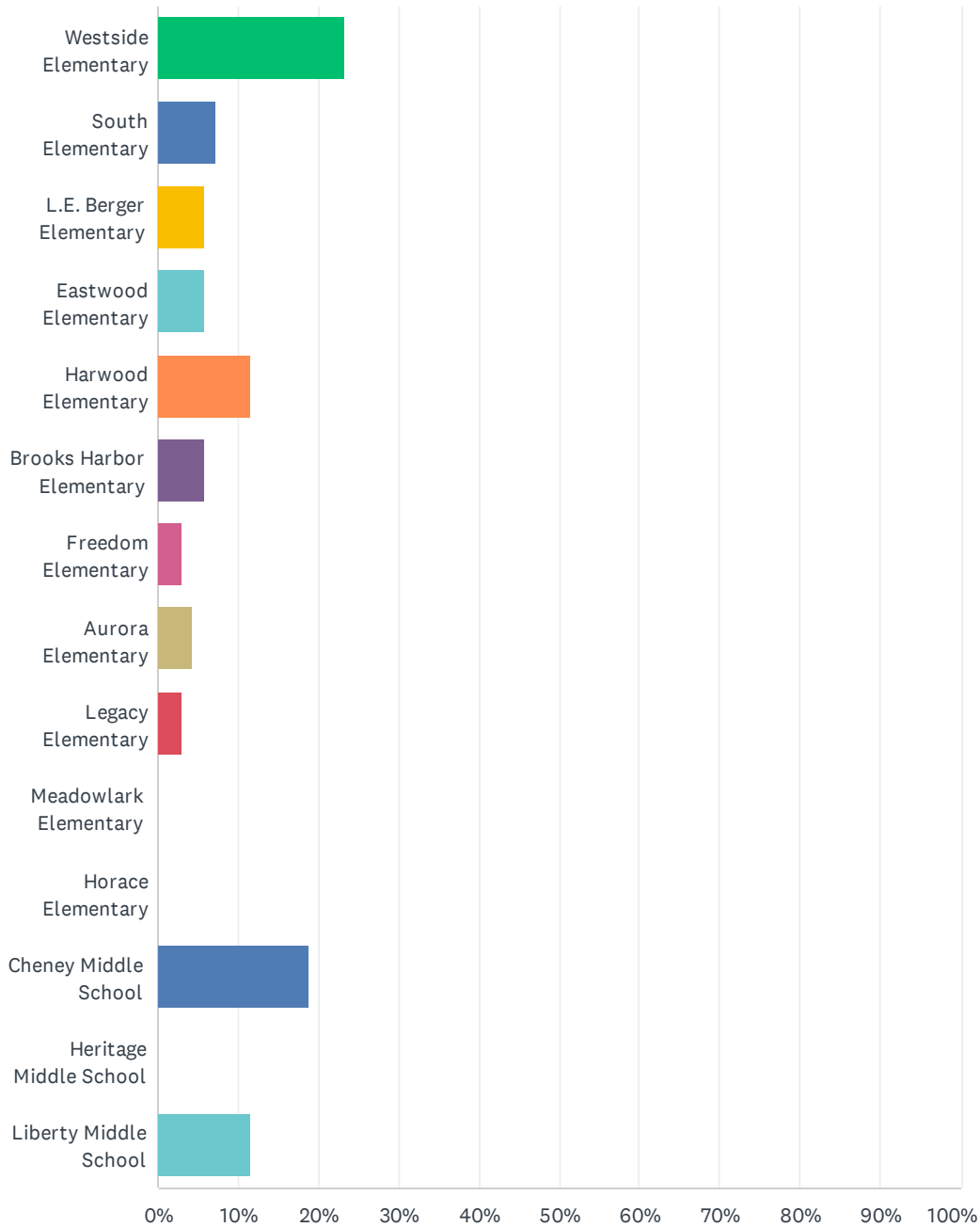

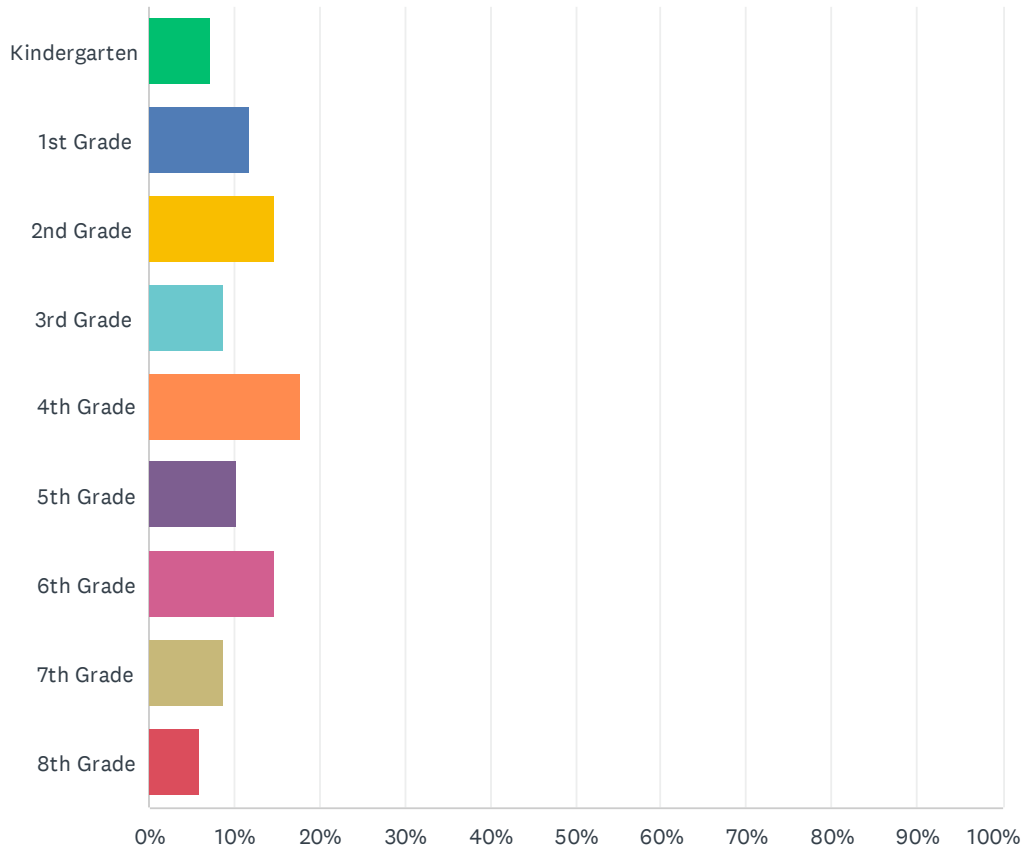

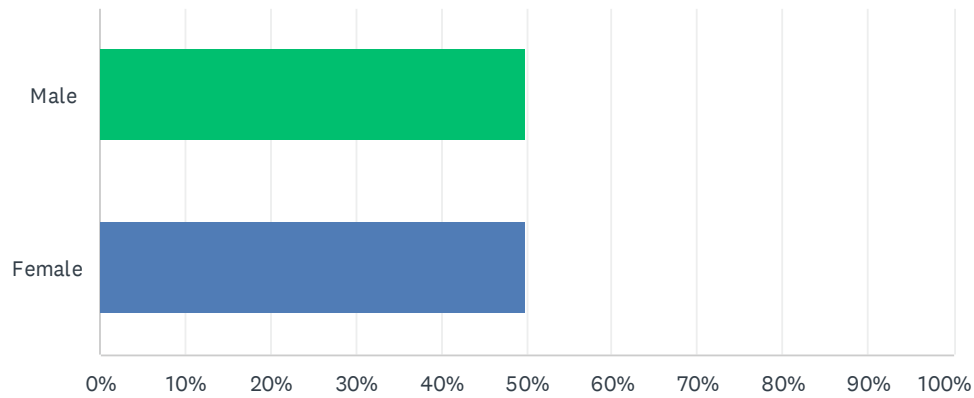

Q3 Is the child for whom you're completing this survey male or female?

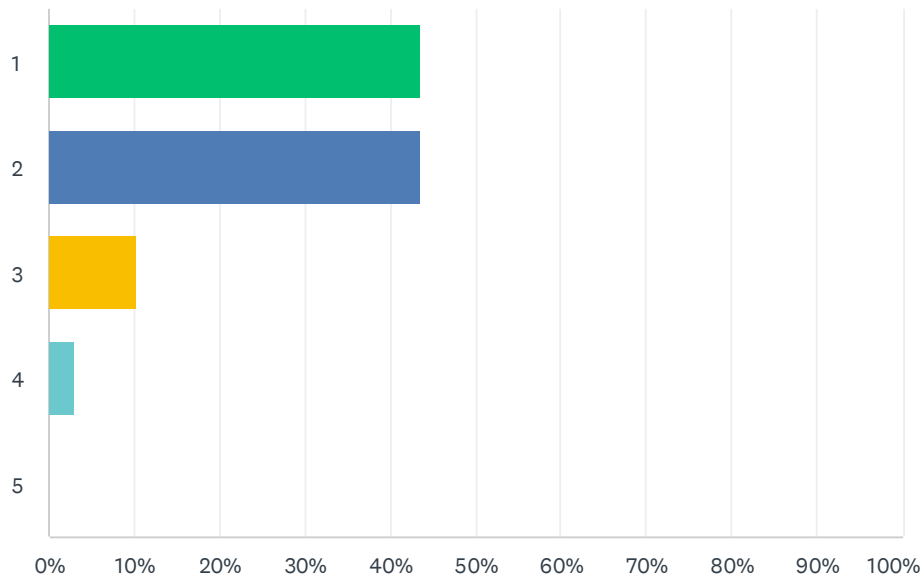

Q4 How many children do you have in Kindergarten through 8thGrade?

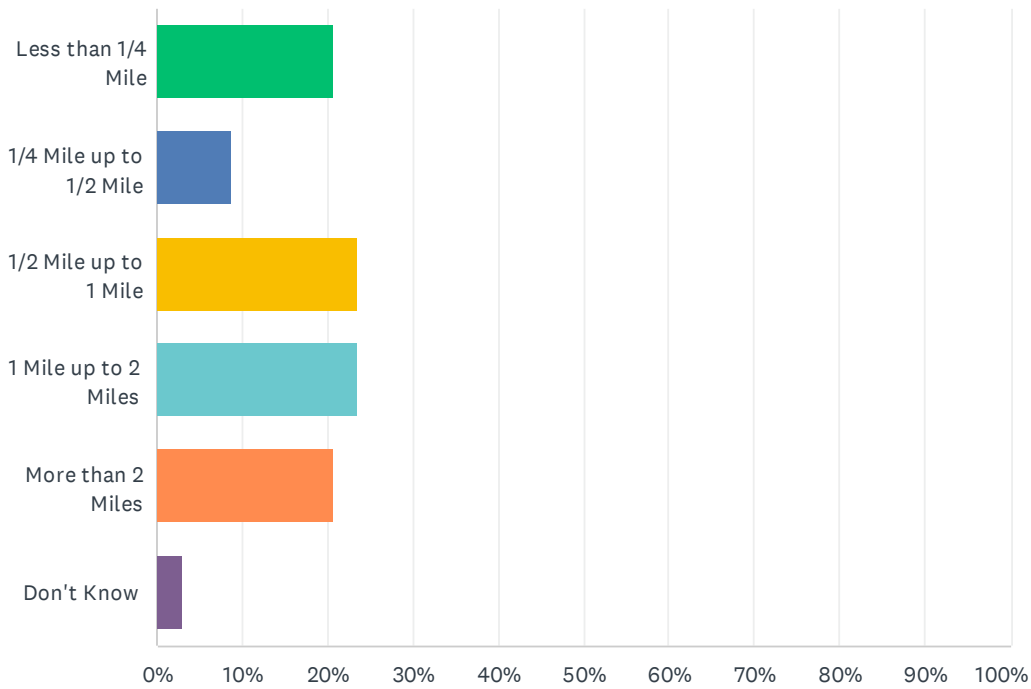

Q5 How far does your child live from school?

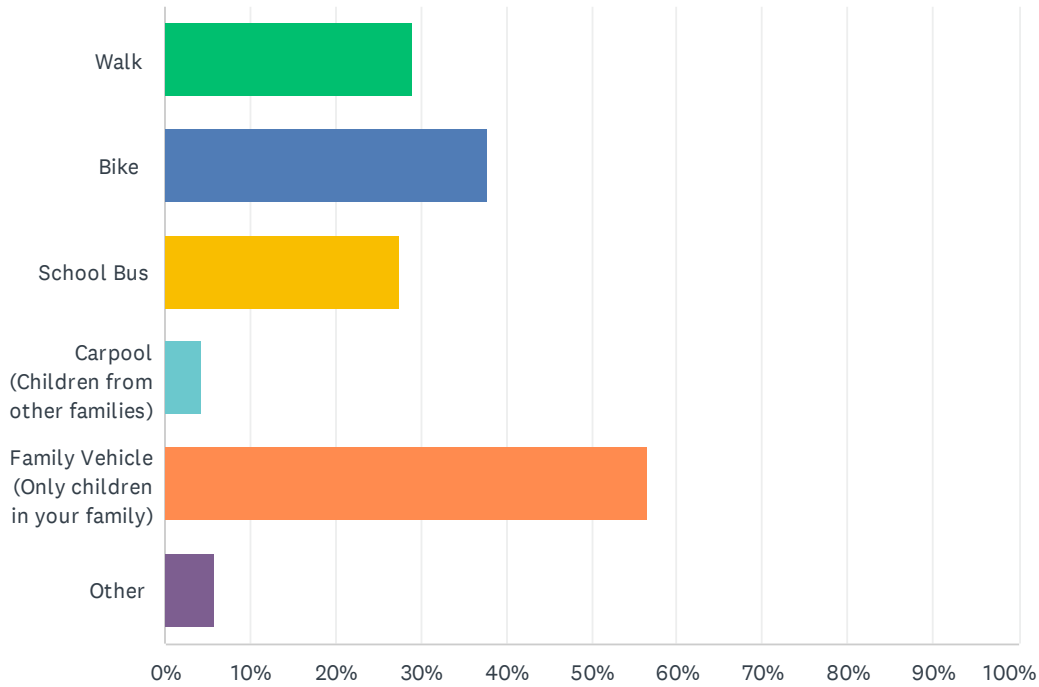

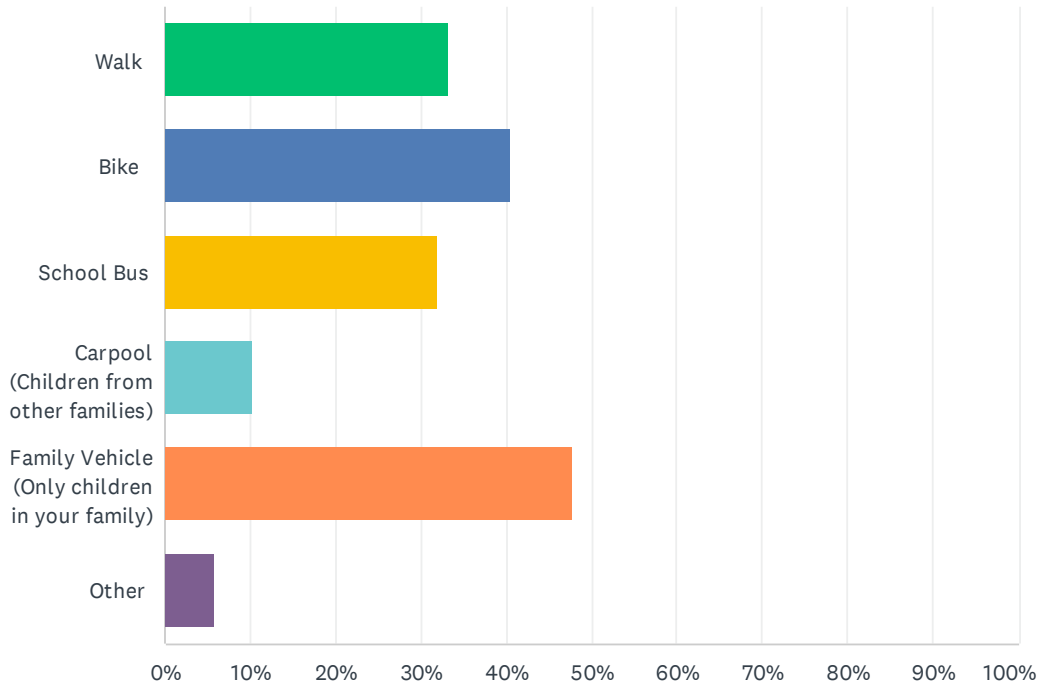

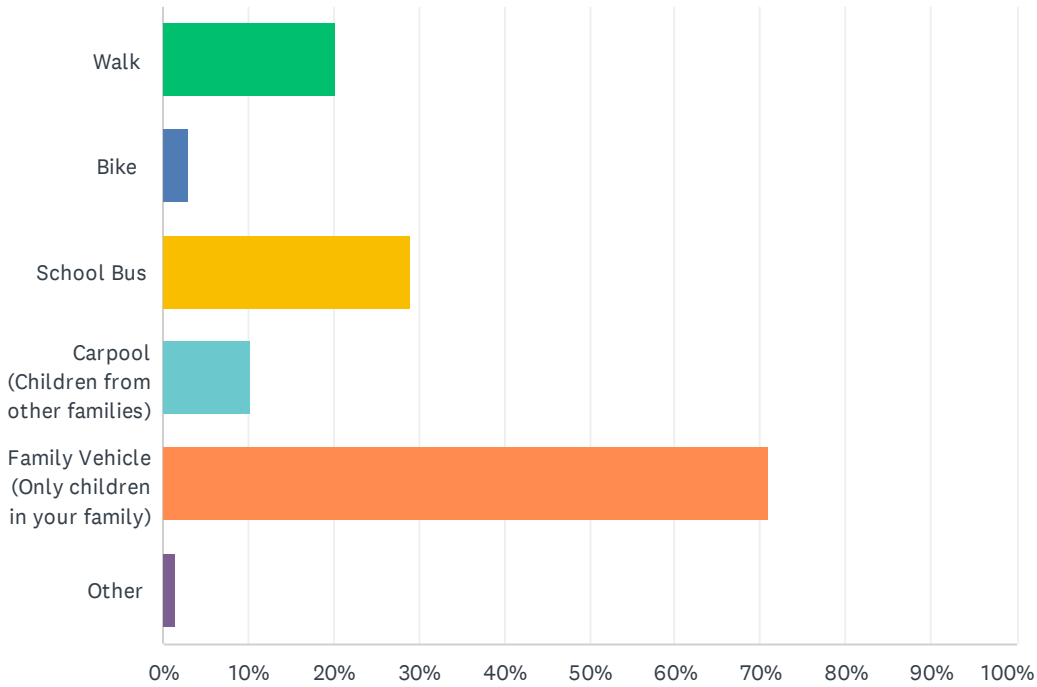

Q8 How does your child arrive to school in the Winter?

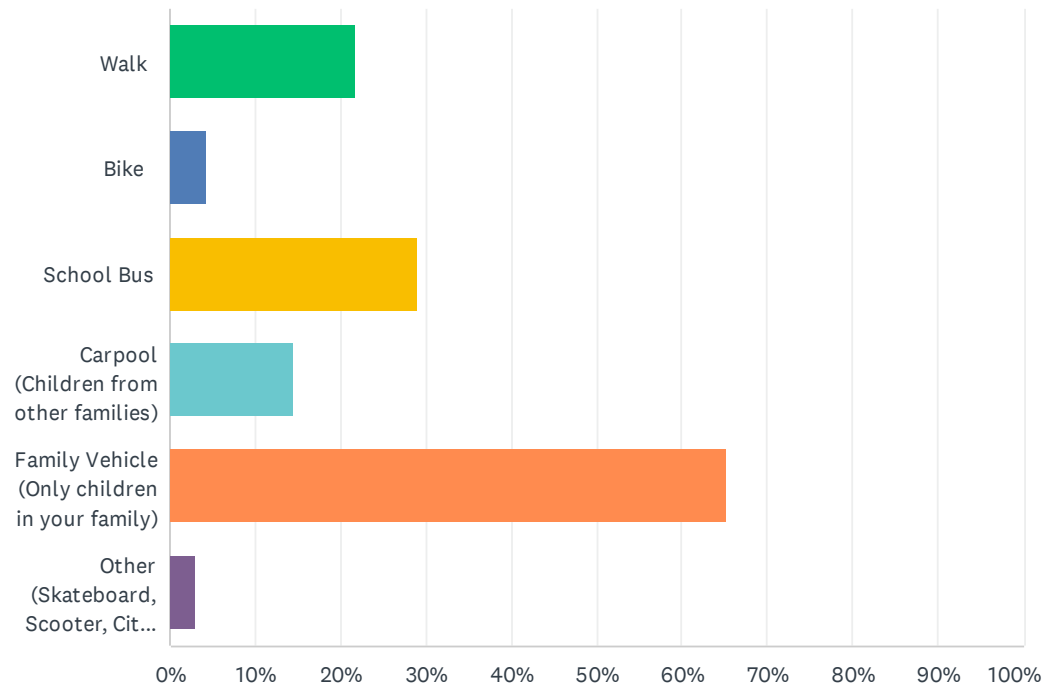

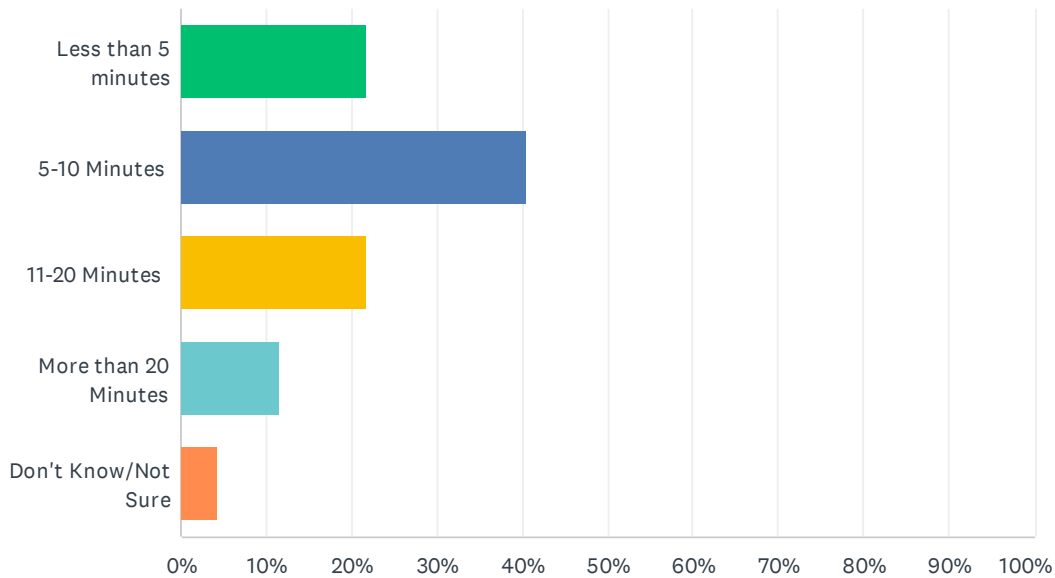

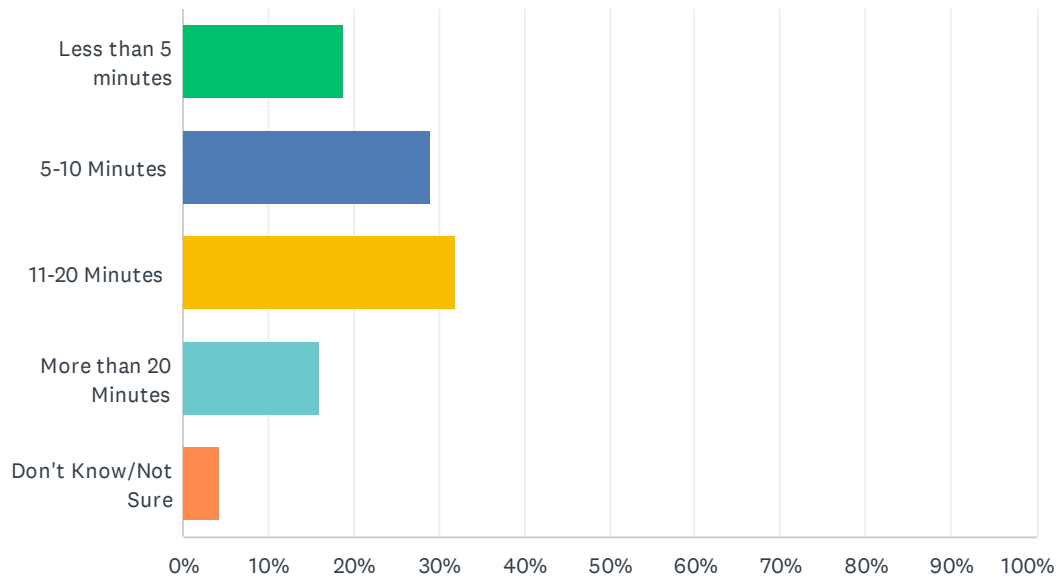

Q11 How long does it normally take your child to get home from school?

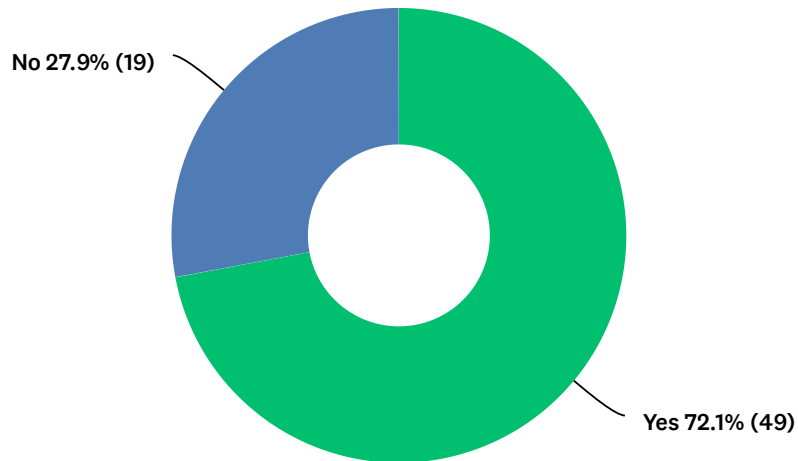

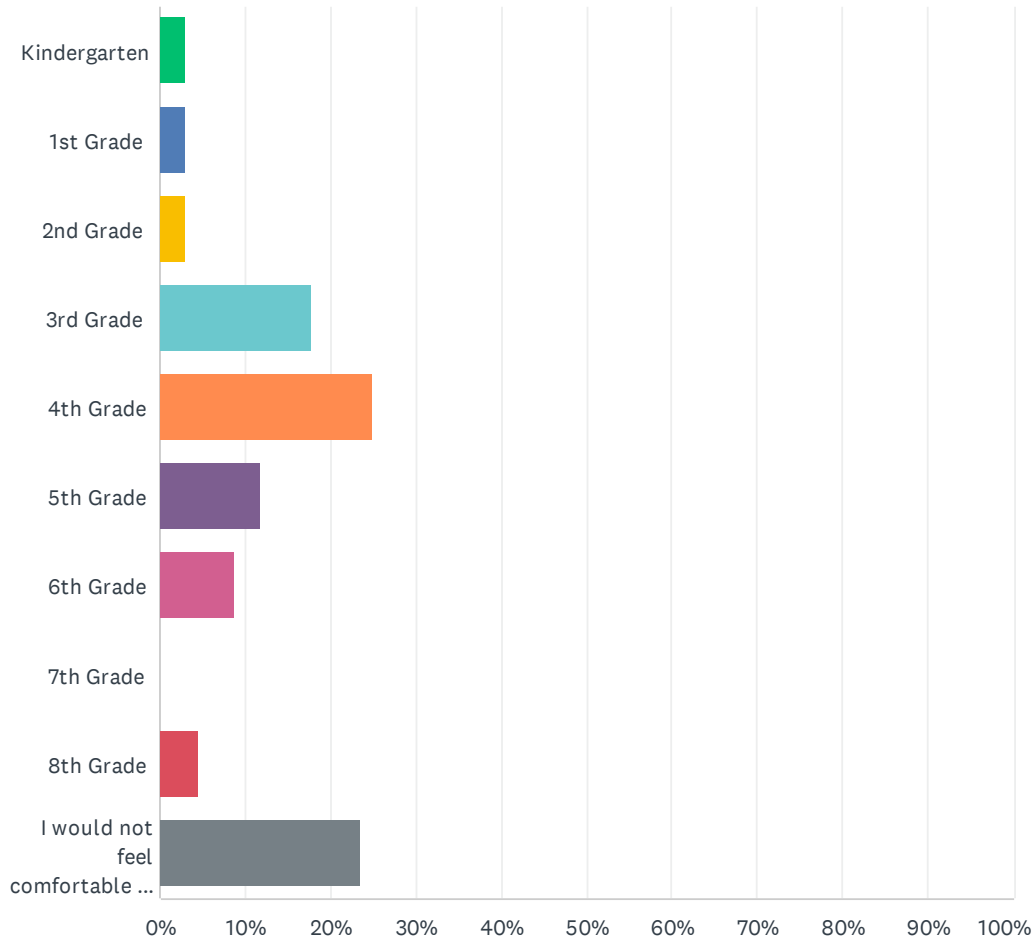

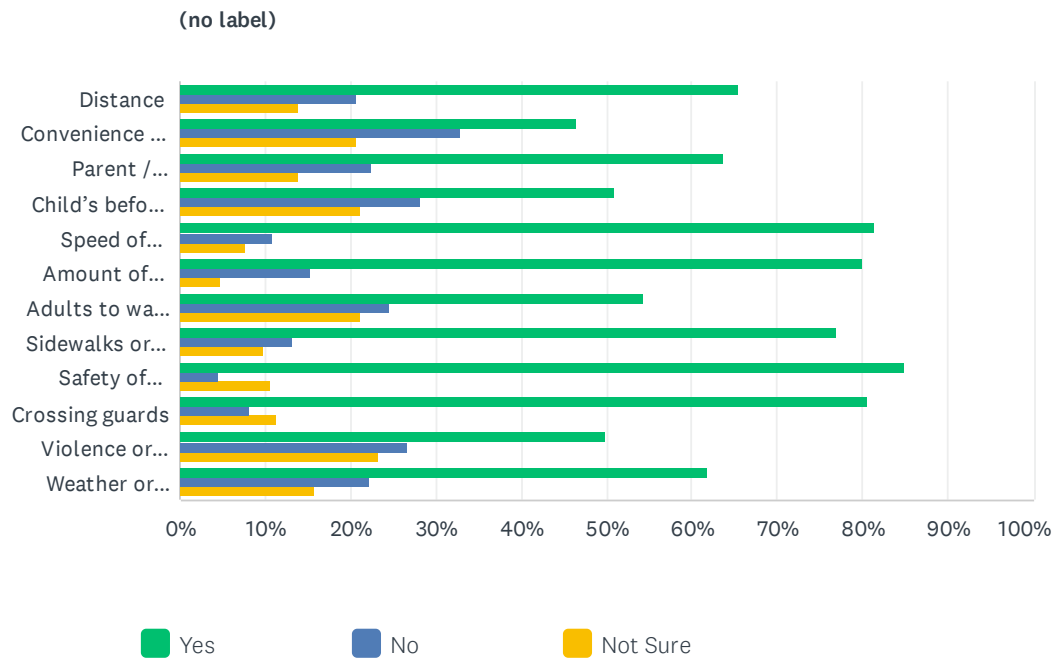

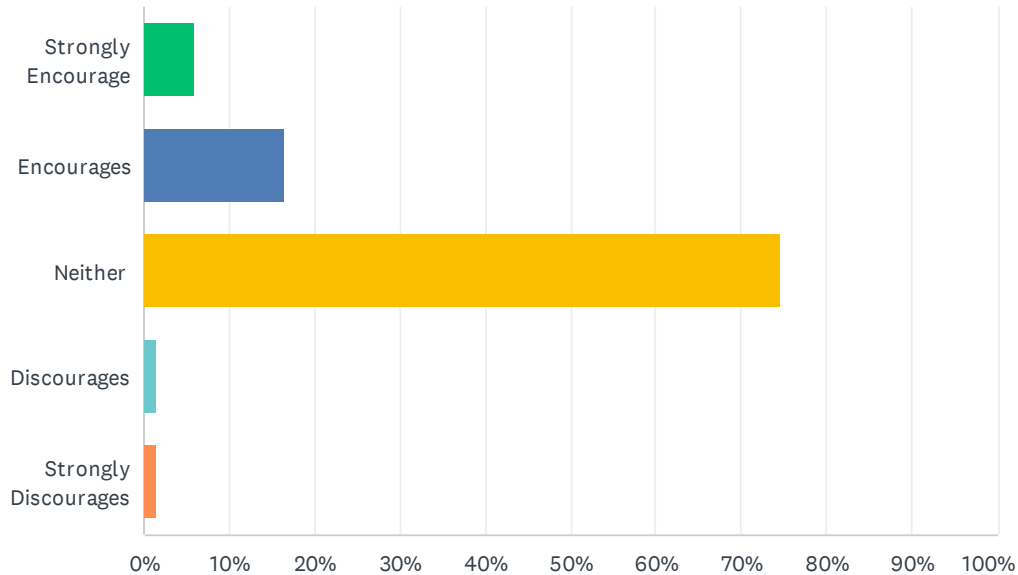

Q15 In your opinion, how much does your child's school encourage or discourage walking and biking to/from school?

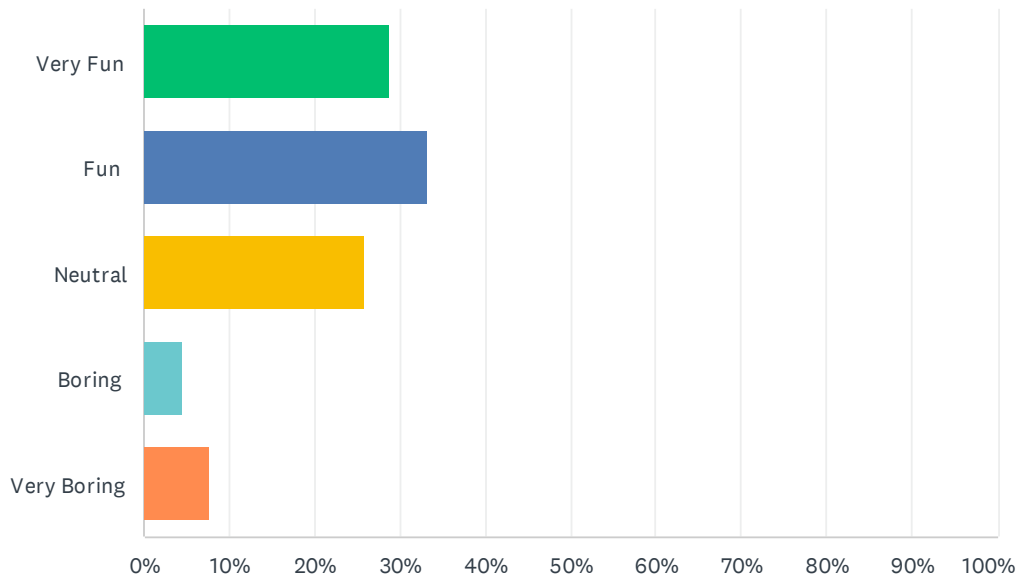

Q16 How much fun is walking or biking to/from school for your child?

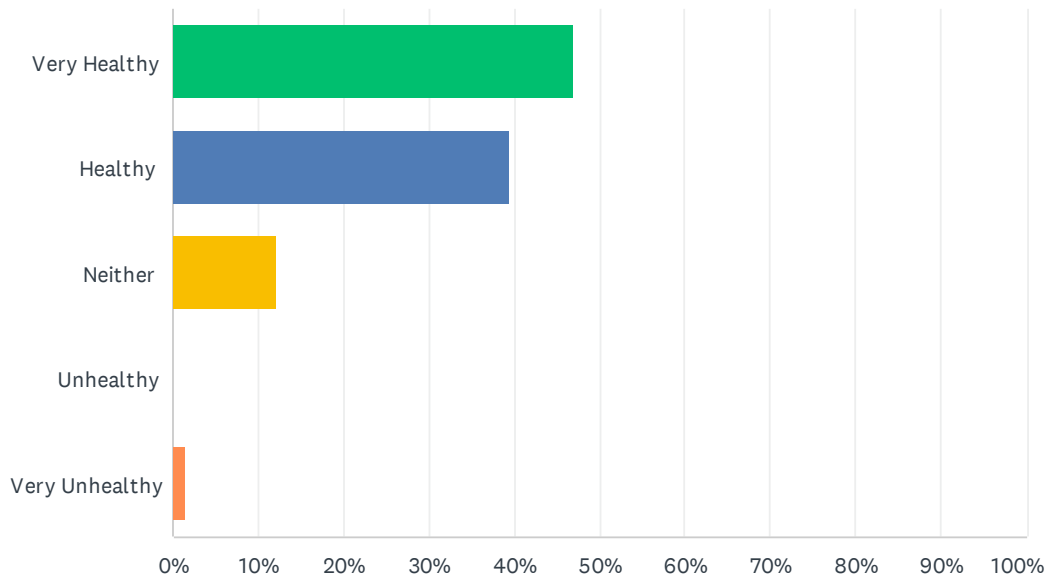
