1a. MEETING CALLED TO ORDER, WELCOME, AND INTRODUCTIONS, convened

The meeting was called to order at 4:00 pm, on August 17, 2023 by Chair Hendrickson, noting a quorum was present. Introductions were made.

1b. Approve Order and Contents of Overall Agenda, approved

Chair Hendrickson asked for approval for the overall agenda.

MOTION: Approve the contents of the Overall Agenda of the August 17, 2023 Policy Board Meeting.

MOTION, passed

Motion carried unanimously.

1c. Past Meeting Minutes, approved

Chair Hendrickson asked for approval of the Minutes of the July 20, 2023 Meeting.

MOTION: Approve the July 20, 2023 Policy Board Meeting Minutes. Ms. White moved, seconded by Ms. Preston MOTION, passed Motion carried unanimously.

1d. Monthly Bills, approved

Chair Hendrickson asked for approval of the August 2023 Bills as listed on Attachment 1d.

MOTION: Approve the August 2023 Bills List. Mr. Breitling moved, seconded by Mr. Krabbenhoft MOTION, passed Motion carried unanimously.

2. CONSENT AGENDA

Chair Hendrickson asked for approval of Items a-b on the Consent Agenda.

MOTION: Approve Items a-b on the Consent Agenda. Mr. Strand moved, seconded by Ms. Preston MOTION, passed Motion carried unanimously.

3. REGULAR AGENDA

3a. Public Comment Opportunity

No public comments were made or received.

3b. 2024-2027 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Adoption

Mr. Bervik presented the final draft of the 2024-2027 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for final submission and adoption. Metro COG solicited public input throughout the development of the TIP. Metro COG held a public input meeting at the June 15, 2023 Policy Board meeting to release the draft TIP and kick off the TIP update process. Metro COG then held a public open house, introducing the elements of the Final Draft 2024-2027 TIP to the public on July 25, 2023. The Final Draft TIP was also made available for review on Metro COG's website.

Since the initial draft document was released in June, Metro COG updated language throughout the document as well as updating projects through its coordination with state and local governments. These changes were reflected in the Final Draft 2024-2027 TIP that was presented

at the Public Open House. Mr. Bervik also shared the few comments received at the public open house.

Ms. White asked about the bicycle/pedestrian path planned near the VA, Mr. Bervik responded that it is programmed into the 2025 TIP.

MOTION: Approval of the Final Draft Metro COG 2024-2027 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP).

Ms. White moved, seconded by Ms. White MOTION, passed

Motion carried unanimously.

3c. Proposed Adjusted Urbanized Boundary – Final Submission

Mr. Maddox presented the Proposed Adjusted Urbanized Boundary. The UZA is set by the 10-year census results, and the MPO then proposes an adjusted boundary, based on many contributing factors.

As directed by the guidance, the proposed boundary ensures the inclusion of the entirety of the right of way of significant roadways within the UZA. City boundaries were used when either significant roadways, the Fargo – Moorhead Area Diversion Project alignment, or other physical boundaries did not present themselves as a logical choice for boundary cutoff. In the following subsections, Metro COG will provide how the boundary was formalized through the quantification of jobs and households from studies, and collaboration with Cass County concerning the FM Area Diversion Project and CMC roadways.

MOTION: Approval the Proposed Adjusted Urbanized Boundary for NDDOT Final Submittal.

Mr. Breitling moved, seconded by Mr. Krabbenhoft

MOTION, passed Motion carried unanimously.

3d. Dilworth-Glyndon-Felton (DGF) Safe Routes to School Plan

Mr. Farnsworth presented the Dilworth-Glyndon-Felton (DGF) Safe Routes to School Plan. This planning study was conducted in cooperation with the DGF School District, the City of Dilworth, the City of Glyndon, and PartnerSHIP 4 Health. This plan also involved public and parent engagement as well as student surveys to help inform and guide the study.

The purpose of this study is to layout a framework to make walking and biking to school safe and more inviting for students. This study identifies existing challenges, safety concerns, and policies and recommends improvements which can improve the walkability and bikeability to/from the DGF schools.

MOTION: Approve the Dilworth-Glyndon-Felton (DGF) Safe Routes to School Plan Ms. Nash moved, seconded by Mr. Gunkelman MOTION, passed

Motion carried unanimously.

4. Additional Business

Mr. Griffith brought a couple updates to the board:

- Kick-off of the 2022 indirect rate (overhead) audit
- 2023 UPWP Amendment #2 finally approved by NDDOT/FHWA
- ND MPO Director's Meeting coming up in September
- No update in funding redistribution from either NDDOT or MnDOT
- Interview process, three candidates coming into the office next week

Chair Hendrickson recognized Mr. Lindaas as this was his last meeting, while he was not in attendance, he did thank him for his service to the Policy Board.
