















## ENGAGEMENT SUMMARY

The Fargo-Moorhead Metropolitan Council of Governments (Metro COG) is updating the Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) to forward the regional multimodal transportation system into an even more accessible, safe, and connected network for the Fargo-Moorhead region. This round of engagement provided multiple opportunities to gather valuable public input to guide strategies and recommended actions of the plan.
