6. FHWA Performance Measure #1

Ms. Pierce presented FHWA Performance Measure #1. Performance Measure #1 is in regards to roadway safety and each state must annually establish and report performance targets for the HSIP. Metro COG is required by FHWA to either agree to program projects established by the respective states, and/or establish MPO specific safety performance targets. Staff recommends adopting both NDDOT and MnDOT Safety Performance Measures, and signing resolutions for each. Mr. Weil commended Ms. Pierce for her research and presentation.

Motion: Recommend Policy Board approval to adopt MnDOT/NDDOT Safety Performance Measures and signing both resolutions.

Mr. Weil moved, seconded by Mr. Gorden.

MOTION, PASSEDMotion carried unanimously.

7. Additional 2018 CPG Projects

Interim Chair Maddox brought up the Metro COG CPG surplus. A UPWP amendment will likely be brought forward in February, and Mr. Maddox will be soliciting projects from the jurisdictions, which will then need to be prioritized. Mr. Maddox has spoken with, or plans to speak with, each jurisdiction individually as well.
